Receiving Credit

Bring in your books in good *readable* condition. I then figure up your credit and give you a credit slip to use at your leisure to get other books- no expiration.

Figuring Credit

I figure credit by taking the cover price and dividing by 5.

Example: \$6.99 new, \$1.40 credit

*Hardbacks are figured at paperback price.

How Do I Use My Credit?

The credit slip is divided into categories:

1. Videos, CD's, Audio Example: If you bring in video's, CD's, tapes for credit- you can use your slip from Line #1 down.
2. General, Non-Fiction
3. Monthly Romance If you bring in monthly romance you can only use your credit for monthly romance (Line 3).

*When you use your credit you use 3/4 credit & 1/4 cash

Example: \$1.00 owed 75 cents off credit slip

25 cents you pay

Everyone pays 1/4 to generate cash flow in the store.
